



Mathematics Intervention Strategy Mats

Resource Descriptions

Resource Name	Description
<p><i>Analytical & Applied Sciences (AA&S) Intervention Strategy Mats</i></p> 	<p>A four-quadrant mat that identifies strategies designed to move students through concrete, semi-concrete, and abstract stages of development. Strategy Mats can be used by the classroom teacher to get ideas for how to embed and connect past grade-level CCSS to current grade-level CCSS. Strategy Mats can also be used by a teacher to provide CCSS-specific intervention to tier 2 and 3 students.</p>
<p><i>Analytical & Applied Sciences (AA&S) Progress Monitoring Probes</i></p> 	<p>Assessments written to assess each stage of the Intervention Strategies Mat (Concrete, Semi-Concrete, Abstract). Each probe is assigned a number that can be used to monitor student intervention progress.</p>

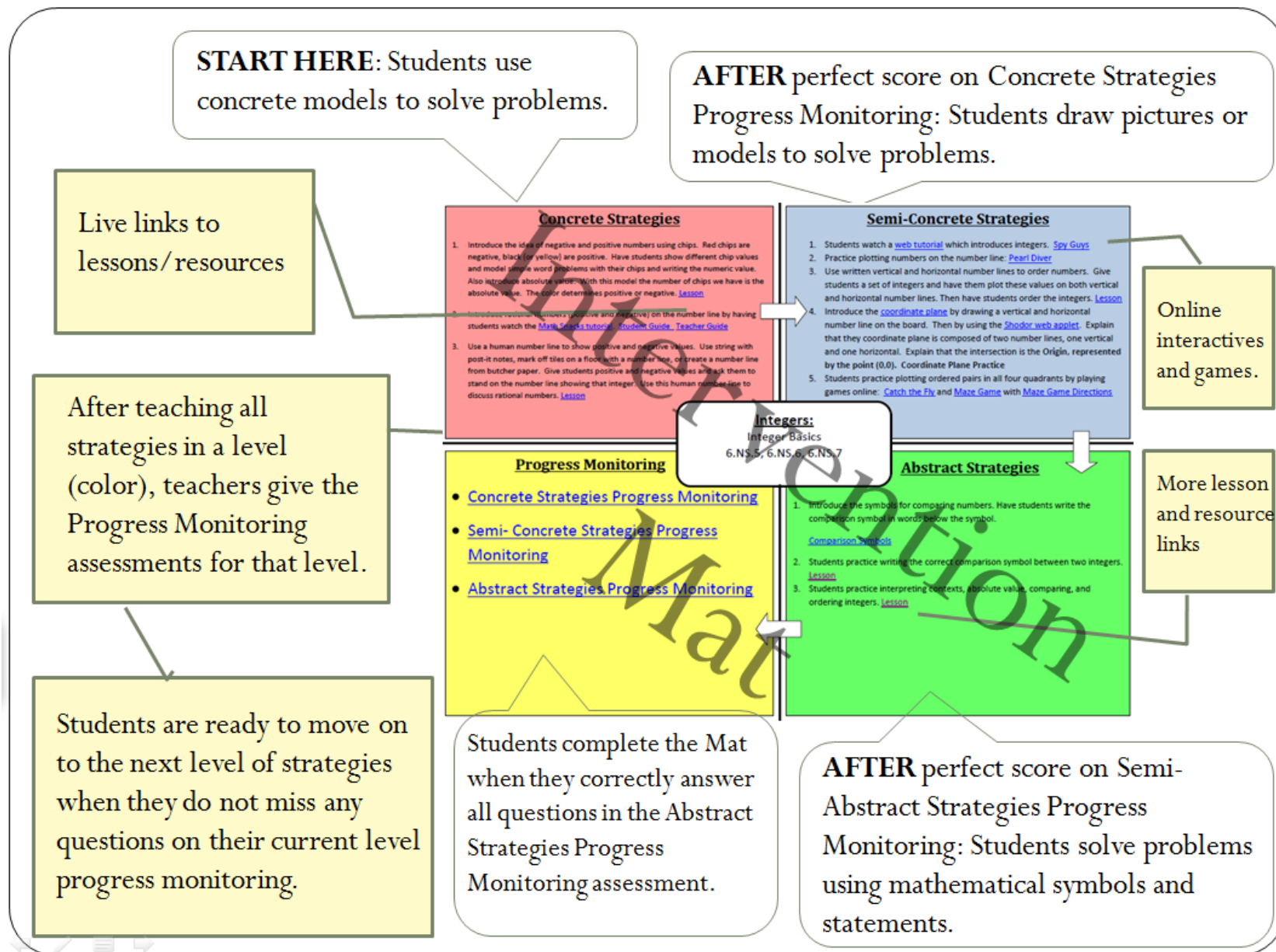
Click on the CCSSM standard identified for intervention
