<b>0</b>	3+ missing sub-topics	There are 5+ incorrect details	Students does not demonstrate any depth of understanding	Has a problem with all three areas.	There is a problem with all three areas

**Helpful Hints:**

1. Think of this as if you are explaining, through writing, how to do your chosen topic for Level 3. You are explaining that what and how of your topic as if the person reading it has never done this before and needs to learn how. Your reader should be able to do this topic after reading your Learning Activity and practicing on your worksheet. So include every sub-topic and every possible variation of that topic that you can.
2. Make a 10-question worksheet regarding your assigned topic that practices the ideas you presented.
