Learners go through a systematic teaching method that engages them in learning knowledge and skills through an extended inquiry process structured around complex, authentic questions and carefully designed products and tasks. (www.bie.org)

Key PBL Tools in the Problem Solving Process

Steps	Tools
Phase 1: Define the problem	Event Event Need-to-Knows Problem Statement/ Driving Question
Phase 2: Solution Criteria	Standards Rubrics Group Contracts
Phase 3: Solution Research	Community Partner Scaffolding of Appropriate Activities and Content Scaffolding of 21 st Century Skills Proposals
Phase 4: Select a Solution	Protocols for Feedback on Ideas Evaluation and Decision-Making Tools Revisit Rubric
Phase 5: Implement and Run Solution	Final Products
Phase 6: Reflect on Solution	Self-Assessment Summative Assessment Class and Personal Reflection
